#### Main Idea:

# The <u>reason</u> we rejoice, pray, and give thanks is that it is the will of God in Christ Jesus for us.

Read Verses 16-18.

### 1.) This Is the Will of God for You

"For this is the will of God, your sanctification." (1 Thessalonians 4:3)

- A.) Rejoice Always
- B.) Pray Without Ceasing
- C.) In Everything, Give Thanks

Because I belong to him, Christ, by his Holy Spirit, assures me of eternal life and makes me wholeheartedly willing and ready from now on to live for him."—Heidelberg Catechism

A.) "In Christ Jesus" Grounds These Three Imperatives in the <u>Irrevocable Grace</u> of God That is Ours Through Christ.

- B.) What God <u>Demands</u> of His People, He Also <u>Gives</u>
- C.) These Mandates aren't Necessary in Order to Receive Something
- D.) They are Necessary Because They are the Inevitable Result of That Which We Have Received
- E.) The Will of God is the Gift of God in Christ Jesus

#### F. ) This Gift is Certain
