#### A.) A Personal Problem

**2 Samuel 6:3**, "...bring up from there the ark of God, whose name is called by the Name, the Lord of Hosts, who dwells between the cherubim."

**John 17:3**, "And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent."

# B.) A **Universal** Problem

**Exodus 19:21**, "And the Lord said to Moses, "Go down and warn the people, lest they break through to gaze at the Lord, and many of them perish"

**Exodus 19:23-24**, "But Moses said to the Lord, "The people cannot come up to Mount Sinai; for You warned us, saying, 'Set bounds around the mountain and consecrate it.' " **24** Then the Lord said to him, "Away! Get down and then come up, you and Aaron with you. But do not let the priests and the people break through to come up to the Lord, lest He break out against them."

**Exodus 20:18-19**, "Now all the people witnessed the thunderings, the lightning flashes, the sound of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking; and when the people saw it, they trembled and stood afar off. **19** Then they said to Moses,

"You speak with us, and we will hear; but let not God speak with us, lest we die."
