# 2.) The Theology of the Hymn

#### A.) Glorify Christ Because He Reconciles Us

\_Read Luke 2:8-14

"Peace on earth and mercy mild, God and sinners reconciled. 2 Corinthians 5:14-19, "**I4** For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died; **I5** and He died for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them and rose again. **I6** Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know Him thus no longer. **I7** Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. **I8** Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, **I9** that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation."

## B.) Glorify Christ Because He is Emmanuel
