1 Peter 1:8-9, "whom having not seen you love Though now you do not see Him, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory,"

v.1"His right hand and His holy arm have gained Him the victory"

v. 2, "The Lord has made known His salvation..."

For there is no difference; **23** for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, **24** being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, **25** whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith..."

Verse 2, "His righteousness He has revealed in the sight of the nations,"

Isaiah 52:10, "The Lord has made bare His holy arm In the eyes of all the nations; And all the ends of the earth shall see The salvation of our God."

verse 8-9, "...Let the hills be joyful together 9 before the Lord, For He is coming to judge the earth..."
