- 1.) <u>Adam</u> Failed to Live Justly, Holy, and Faithfully Before the Lord
- 2.) Israel Failed to Live Justly, Holy, and Faithfully Before the Lord
- 3.) The True Israel, Jesus Christ, Would Be <u>Perfectly Just, Completely</u> Holy, and <u>Always</u> Faithful Unto the Lord
