1.) God's People Will Be Unfaithful

Verse 44, "Yet for all that..."

Verse 44, "Yet in spite of this..." ('95 NASB)

Read Verse 43.

Verse 44, "Yet for all that, when they are in the land of their enemies..."

Psalm 139:4, "For there is not a word on my tongue, But behold, O Lord, You know it altogether."

Isaiah 46:9-10, "...For I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like Me, IO Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times things that are not yet done...

2 Kings 21:2-6

Jeremiah 5:1-3

Jeremiah 6:6, "...She is full of oppression in her midst."

Jeremiah 6:13, "Because from the least of them even to the greatest of them, Everyone is given to covetousness; And from the prophet even to the priest, Everyone deals falsely."
